5. Find the model of the Space Shuttle.
 - a. What date was the first Space Shuttle launched? April 12, 1981
 - b. What was the name of the last Space Shuttle to fly? Discovery
6. Find the model of the International Space Station.
 - a. What year did the International Space Station (ISS) launch? 1998
 - b. How long does it take the ISS to orbit Earth? 93 minutes

Find the Moon globe.

7. Name one country, other than the United States, that has landed on the Moon.
Russia/USSR or China

Find the Brief History of Pre-History / Fossil Case.

8. What is the state fossil of Illinois? Tullimonstrum gregarium or Tully Monster

9. How many of the fossils on display are fish? two

Find the Eyes on the Skies Telescopes Case.

10. What is the name of the telescope which "sees" infrared light? James Webb Space Telescope

11. Which type of telescope only uses a lens to focus light, a refracting telescope or a reflecting telescope? refracting telescope
