PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Part 1: Attend in-person instruction twice weekly.

Part 2: Attend in-person instruction twice weekly and engage in a paid 30-hour campus employment experience.

Part 3: Engage in a 75-hour (7.5 hours per week/10 weeks) community employment experience.

Triton College staff support participants and employers during the community employment experience. Participants will develop a work schedule with the employer partner based on the employer's and participant's mutually available hours.

Upon successful completion of all three required parts, all lessons and both employment experiences, participants will receive the S.E.E.D. (Skill Enhancement and Employee Development) Certificate through the School of Continuing Education.
