J. Murphy noted that P. Jaswilko revised the wording to the 'Program Prerequisites' and 'Prerequisite Courses' for C218A, Nursing, Associate Degree to read, 'completion of MAT 085 or MAT 170 or successful placement scores permitting entrance into MAT 110, MAT 111, MAT 114, MAT 124 or MAT 131, and RHT 101'. P. Jaswilko added that NUR 109 was added to semester three as an option only for LPNs. S. Campos asked if the program can be published. S. Misasi Maratto replied yes, as long as 'Pending ICCB Approval' is noted after the program title. A. Turner questioned if provisions have been made for students to complete who are in the current Nursing program. P. Jaswilko replied that they will be taken counseled. J. Murphy stated that C317D, Nursing, Practical has been inactivated and no new students would be allowed to enter. S. Campos commended P. Jaswilko for his diligent work to complete the Nursing program revision. J. Murphy added that it was an asset that P. Jaswilko conveyed the information requested in the TRC.

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W. Justiz stated that C444F, advanced Fire Officer Certificate is not an 'advanced' certificate, which requires a degree, but is a basic certificate with the title of 'advanced'. L. Wester asked when a prerequisite states that the student must be a firefighter. Would the student need to verify this by showing verification? W. Justiz replied the student would have to show proof of their certification from the State Fire Marshal. M. Flaherty asked W. Justiz if he would consider signing students into the

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next course, as he does with the Scholar's students. W. Justiz replied ves, he has thought about registering the students. L. Wester added that the counselors would need to know what to ask the student for to fulfill the course prerequisite. A. Turner added if the students should be asked for their certification and a copy of the documentation. W. Justiz replied, yes and he can also be contacted for a signature. The courses will be published. J. Murphy asked if the program prerequisite should be changed to reflect this requirement. M. Flaherty added that it is not listed in the course description either and added that he registers the Scholar's students for their entire schedule. W. Justiz stated that the prerequisite for the certificate would also pertain to all of the courses. L Wester stated that would work only at first. W. Justiz stated that he has included the requirement in each course prerequisite. S. Campos stated that W. Justiz could sign for the course, as they cannot show the certificate alone. L. Wester asked if the students need to show some kind of proof, then would the counselors be responsible for. A. Turner asked if the student has credentials, can they register online. W. Justiz replied they would need to come in person. J. Murphy requested current Advisory Minutes for the new certificates, courses and revisions. W. Justiz stated that the Advisory Minutes are the latest and these submissions were held up by the changes the State made. J. Murphy stated that should be noted in the rationale, as all curriculum changes are required to support the changes being made. The prerequisite for EMS 131 will read, 'High school graduate or 'High School Equivalency and at least 18 years of age by time of State exam' striking exception of Dual **Credit students** .... C. Antonich stated that the prerequisite for any college course is the same required for dual credit students. S. Misasi Maratto noted that what is listed in the course prerequisite will be honored and entered in Colleague, and added if a requirement is not stated in the prerequisite there is no restriction for the course. J. Murphy added that the topics and some objectives could be enhanced, especially FIR 204, FIR 205 and FIR 206. W. Justiz stated that he revised his last submissions and the State told him not to revise anything. L. Wester stated these items can be voted on, but do not know if the State will guestion anything. W. Justiz stated if the State denies the courses, he will go back to the Fire Marshal at the State. J. Cody asked if he did not use the exact verbiage the State has, they would give him a hard time? W. Justiz replied they would or they might deny them. J. Cody asked would not the State recognize that he captured the meaning if he reworded the topics and objectives. J. Murphy asked if he had revised courses in the past. S. Campos stated that the ICCB asked them to revise. W. Justiz stated that the courses had to be changed through the curriculum process. M. Flaherty added that under this circumstance W. Justiz needs to proceed this way. J. Murphy stated that the Committee is not here to criticize, only to ensure that the State will approve our submissions.

Motion to approve item numbers 17-180 through 17-195, passed unanimously by voice vote, with the revision to the prerequisite for EMS 131.

# OTHER: A.) Updating Course Outlines – J. Murphy

J. Murphy stated that the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) is coming to Triton in March 2018 and we need to have updated electronic copies of all courses, which include Assessment and General Education Outcomes. She added if the course outlines are 6 plus years old, they would need to be updated through the Curriculum process. L. Wester suggested everyone review their courses as there is some talk the HLC will be reviewing them. M. Flaherty stated there is not enough preparation to get out the message and most people won't get the message and suggested sending out a notification to chairs and coordinators. J. Murphy asked deans to contact them. S. Misasi Maratto added that any course outlines prior to 2011 would need to be revised to the new curriculum format.

# B). <u>Course Outline Necessary for Each Course Offered – J. Murphy</u>

J. Murphy stated that a course outline is required for any course that is offered, as the HLC may request them. S. Campos stated that these courses should come to Curriculum in February if the HLC is coming in March. H. Bohleke added that he is concerned that some of the course outlines in his area are older. S. Misasi Maratto developed a Log of course and program changes from 1993 to the present. K. Li questioned if there is any alignment with TK20.

S. Misasi Maratto stated that the College Curriculum Committee will meet in a new room next Spring. J. Murphy stated the room number is E-202.
