

**Operational Assembly:** Kurian Tharakunnel provided highlights from the September 12 Assembly. Academic Affairs reported on new programs, increased enrollment for *English as a Second Language*, and Hispanic Heritage Month events. Student Affairs reported on the new *TimelyMD* app that provides mental and physical health support for students. Technology reported that *Elucian Experience* will be replacing the portal and mobile app. Research reported that the Student Satisfaction Survey has been completed and is posted on the website.

**Academic Senate:** Michael Flaherty provided highlights from the September 13 Senate meeting. Curriculum reported that electrical and welding certificates are now permanent and that RHT is now named English Rhetoric and Composition I and II. Academic Support is reviewing a Board Policy related to CAAS, and will begin to review the late registration policy. Assessment is currently evaluating Quantitative Literacy 2022-2023 and finalizing Faculty Assessment Fellows. Online Education & Technology reports there are eighteen online courses in pilot form. Senate is reviewing a bylaw change for clarification of Technology East and West membership.

**Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Events:** Purva DeVol reported on DEI projects, including a webpage created to support the college's DEI efforts and a new email created to promote DEI ideas and activities. Hispanic Heritage Month events were reviewed and are available on the website [here](#).

**Student Loan Forgiveness:** Vice President Koslow Martin discussed the federal loan forgiveness plan and pointed out that less than 2 percent of Triton students take out loans.

**Progress Update on Class Cancellation Plans:** Vice President Campos reported that a committee including faculty, deans, and senior administrators has been formed to discuss the raised issue of class cancellation.
