Congratulations to Triton's Newest All-American Athletes!

Monraia Wilson was selected to the NJCAA Division I Third Team All-American Team in Women's Basketball. She is the first NJCAA All-American representing women's basketball in 29 years. Ms. Wilson finished the season ranked 8th in the nation in steals (98) and 35th in assists (122). She finished her Triton career with 858 total points, which is 8th in school history.
