# Tuition Payment Schedule



Registration begins on **Oct. 23, 2023**. Registering early gives you the best selection of classes, can significantly reduce the wait time to see an advisor and allows you to set up a payment plan that gives you up to six (6) months to pay for classes. Register online through the MyTriton portal, in person at the Welcome Center, Room B-100, or by phone with the Call Center at (708) 456-0300, Ext. 3130. Once you register for classes, you must make payment arrangements (see options below).

If you register between...	Tuition Payment Deadline
Oct. 23, 2023-Jan. 1, 2024	Jan. 5, 2024
On or after Jan. 2, 2024	Within five days.

If you do not make payment arrangements within the specified timelines, you **may** be dropped from your selected classes. The college will send an email to your official Triton College email address notifying you of the need to re-enroll. **If you decide not to attend, please remember that you must drop courses for which you have registered. Otherwise, you will be responsible for all tuition and fees.**

### The following PAYMENT OPTIONS are available to students:

- **Payments in full** may be made by cash, money order, check or credit card (MasterCard, Visa, or American Express) at the Cashier's Office (Student Center, Room B-130). You may also pay online through your MyTriton portal.
- **Proof of third party payment** – A third party (e.g., your employer) providing payment on your behalf.
- **Nelnet Payment Plan** – Interest-free monthly installments to be automatically deducted from your bank account or credit card.
  - Program eligibility requires a minimum balance due of \$250 and a \$25 processing fee. A valid bank account or credit card is needed to set up the payment plan.
  - Apply online through your MyTriton portal.

- **Nelnet Pending Aid Payment Plan** – Available for eligible students who have an expected family contribution (EFC) of \$5,900 or less (based on the FAFSA on file in the Financial Aid Office).
  - The \$25 Nelnet processing fee is deferred until the plan is activated. If your financial aid award covers all institutional charges, the plan is canceled with no penalty.
  - If you have an incomplete file or a balance due after the financial aid award has been applied to your account, you may pay the balance due in a one-time payment and cancel the plan with no penalty. Otherwise, the \$25 Nelnet processing fee along with the first of three monthly installments will be charged beginning on **March 5, 2024**.
- **Financial aid holds** will be applied if you have completed your financial aid file and have been awarded grants, loans or scholarships for the spring term.
- All down payments are processed immediately!
- Please note that if someone is paying on your behalf, you must first set them up as an authorized payer.
