

Summer 2019 Tuition Payment Schedule

Advanced registration begins on **February 18, 2019**. Registering early gives you the best selection of classes, can significantly reduce the wait time to see a counselor, and allows you to set up a payment plan that gives you up to three (3) months to pay for classes. You may register online through the [MyTriton portal](#), in person at the Welcome Center (B100), or by phone with the Call Center (ext. 3130). Once you register for classes, you must pay your outstanding balance in full or make payment arrangements.

<i>If you register between...</i>	<i>Tuition Payment Deadline</i>
February 18 - April 28, 2019	May 1, 2019
April 29 - July 30, 2019	Within 2 days

If you do not make payment arrangements within the specified timelines, you **may** be dropped from your selected classes. The College will send an e-mail notifying you of the need to re-enroll. **If you decide not to attend, please remember to drop courses for which you have registered. Otherwise, you will be responsible for all tuition and fees.**

The following **PAYMENT OPTIONS** are available to students.

- **Payments in full** - cash, money order, check, or credit card (MasterCard, Visa, or American Express) at the Cashier's Office (B-130). You can also make credit card payments online through your [MyTriton portal](#).
- **Proof of 3rd party payment** - a 3rd party is providing payment on your behalf (e.g., a company for which you work).
- **FACTS Tuition Payment Plan** - Interest-free monthly installments automatically to be automatically deducted from your bank account or credit card.
 - Program eligibility requires a minimum balance due of \$250 and a \$25 processing fee. A valid bank account or credit card is needed to set up the payment plan.

- **Financial Aid** holds will be applied if you have completed the financial aid application and have been awarded funds for the summer term. You are encouraged to sign up for a payment plan if you have a balance remaining after financial aid has been applied.

Due to FAFSA processing time (usually 3-5 days), you may request a **one-time protective hold (up to 7 days) in the Financial Aid Office** if you register and complete the FAFSA on the same day.
