Humanities, Philosophy or Ethics - 6 semester hours	HUM-101 or higher. PHL-101 or higher.
Fine arts (may not include a performance class) – 3 semester hours	ART-110 to ART-114, ART-210
Social and Behavioral Sciences (must include at least one course in psychology) – 9 semester hours	ANT-101 or higher. ECO-100 to ECO-150. HIS-121 or higher. PSY-100 to PSY-250. SOC-100 to SOC-231.
