Leading the Trojans was Damari Reed (157 lbs), who earned a third-place finish and NJCAA All-American honors following a strong performance throughout the tournament. Leader College Recognition

Triton College has been named a 2026 Leader College by Achieving the Dream (ATD), a national recognition awarded to institutions demonstrating strong student success outcomes and a commitment to access, belonging and achievement.
