Strategic Planning President Mary-Rita Moore presented Triton's new Shared Values as: **Collaboration**, **Diversity**, **Integrity**, **Equity**, and **Excellence**. Shared values are the workplace qualities needed for the college to achieve its mission and vision, and are central to the Strategic Plan.
