Do You Qualify for TWO YEARS OF FREE TUITION?



REQUIREMENTS

- High school seniors who reside in district or attend an in-district high school.
 - Students must have an unweighted cumulative 3.35 GPA at the completion of the first semester of their senior year.
 - Must submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or an Alternative Application for Illinois Financial Aid.
- Please Note: The Alternative Application is intended for qualifying undocumented students. (Triton College FAFSA School Code: 001773)

HOW DO YOU QUALIFY?

Simply include your unweighted cumulative high school GPA on your admission application.
Unofficial transcripts will be required to verify eligibility.

Students must be enrolled in 15 credit hours for the fall and spring semesters.
The Trustee Honors Scholarship covers in-district tuition and fees for fall, spring and summer semesters.*

*Students must complete at least 30 credit hours at the end of the second semester with a 3.0 minimum cumulative GPA for renewal for the next academic year. International students are not eligible for this scholarship.
