

TEAS - Test of Essential Academic Skills Information

The TEAS exam is administered in-person at the Triton College Testing Center, Room A-126 (Learning Resource Center). Dates are available on the ATI TEAS website. Follow the steps below to register.

The exam consists of four parts (Reading, Mathematics, Science and English/Language Usage) and the total time is 209 minutes.

HOW TO REGISTER:

- Visit <https://atitesting.com/teas/register> - choose 'Register Now'
- Choose test method:
 - In-person – search for Triton College by school name and state; 'Select' your preferred date
 - **Dates are posted throughout the year, check back periodically for additions**
 - Online – NOT PROCTORED THROUGH TRITON – to test at home with an ATI proctor, make sure your equipment meets the minimum requirements, and continue to follow the directions on the website
 - Registration and pricing will be different; contact ATI for more information: (800) 667-7531
- Continue to check out, set up an account (or login) and pay the required registration fee of \$97.00

ON YOUR SCHEDULED EXAM DAY:

- Arrive at the Testing Center (A-126) with a valid government-issued photo ID with signature **AND** your ATI TEAS account login username/password on your scheduled date and time
 - ***Students without proper ID will not be permitted to test and will be responsible for repaying/rescheduling a new exam***
- Pencils and scratch paper will be provided; a four-function calculator is built into the platform online
- Plan for the entire process to take about 4 hours
- Examinees will receive immediate results at the end of their testing session

SCORES AND RETESTING POLICY:

Examinees will receive immediate results at the end of their testing session in-person. Scores are not automatically sent to your chosen institution/school. After testing, examinees may request transcripts of their scores to be sent to institutions from ATI at <https://www.atitesting.com>.

ATI does not dictate retest policies. Every institution decides their own retest policies. Examinees applying for education programs will need to check with that institution's TEAS score acceptance policies, as they may vary.
