

#### **TEAS - Test of Essential Academic Skills Information**

Test is administered in-person at the Triton College Testing Center, Room A-126 (Learning Resource Center)

Applicants for admission to the Triton College Nursing and Allied Health programs are welcome to take the TEAS. Test candidates from other institutions are also welcome to register for the TEAS at Triton College.

The TEAS consists of four parts (Reading, Mathematics, Science and English/Language Usage) and the total test time is 209 minutes. Triton College Testing Center is administering the computer-based ATI TEAS exam on-campus, and dates are available on the ATI TEAS website. Follow the steps below to register.

# **HOW TO REGISTER:**

- Visit https://atitesting.com/teas/register choose 'Register Now'
- Choose test method:
  - In-person search for Triton College by school name and state; 'Select' your preferred date
    - \*<u>Dates are posted throughout the year, check back periodically for additions</u>\*
  - Online NOT PROCTORED THROUGH TRITON to test at home with an ATI proctor, make sure your
    equipment meets the minimum requirements, and continue to follow the directions on the website
    - Registration and pricing will be different; contact ATI for more information: (800) 667-7531
- Continue to check out, set up an account (or login) and pay the required registration fee of \$97.00

## ON YOUR SCHEDULED TEST DAY:

- Arrive at the Testing Center (A-126) with a valid government-issued photo ID with signature <u>AND</u> your ATI TEAS
  account login username/password on your scheduled date and time
  - \*\*Students without proper ID will not be permitted to test and will be responsible for repaying/rescheduling a new test\*\*
- Pencils and scratch paper will be provided; a four-function calculator is built into the test platform online
- Plan for the entire process to take about 4 hours
- Examinees will receive immediate results at the end of their testing session

## **REVIEW MATERIALS AND RESOURCES:**

### **SCORES AND RETESTING POLICY:**

Examinees will receive immediate test results at the end of their testing session in-person. <u>Triton Nursing Applicants</u> are eligible to test three times within a two-year period. There is a 30-day wait period between retakes. Test scores are valid for two years, and must be valid on the date the program application is submitted. Triton College accepts TEAS scores taken at other testing locations. Students may request a transcript of their scores from ATI at <a href="https://www.atitesting.com">https://www.atitesting.com</a>. Any scores submitted will count as an attempt.

\*\*\*Examinees applying for education programs outside of Triton College will need to check with their institution's TEAS score acceptance policies, as they may vary.\*\*\*
