Little Wound's Warriors Showcased at Triton College to Recognize Native American Heritage Month

RIVER GROVE – Triton College's Heritage Committee and the Professional Development Center celebrated Native American Heritage Month by showcasing the documentary *Little Wound's Warriors* on Thursday, Nov. 2, at the Cernan Earth and Space Center.

Little Wound's Warriors focuses on the hardships of young Native Americans residing on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation in South Dakota.

Directed by Triton instructor Seth McClellan, the film covers a variety of topics, such as poverty, alcoholism, PTSD, drug abuse, suicide and intergenerational trauma, as well as the perseverance and strength of those on the reservation.

"We know what it means to be a warrior," said one young person in the documentary.

After the film presentation, audience members participated in a question-and-answer reception with McClellan, who shared his experience with making the film.

"I became interested in the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation when I heard about their suicide epidemic," he explained. "I wanted to investigate the people living on the reservation for myself."

To conclude the event, attendees enjoyed soups, made by Triton's HIA students, to commemorate Native American Heritage Month.
