The Access to Literacy program provides free tutoring services to adult learners who wish to build necessary skills to improve their reading, writing, math or English conversation. The program offers one-on-one or small group sessions with flexible meeting times, Monday through Sunday. Trained volunteer tutors work closely with learners to provide support and guidance using individualized learning plans.

Tutors meet adult learners on the Triton College campus, as well as local libraries, for a minimum of two hours a week. Online tutoring options are also available.
