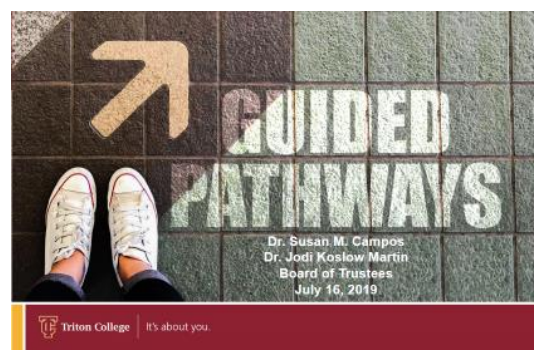
Retirement Congrats!

An introduction to **Guided Pathways** was presented to the Board as a model to direct and assist students in selecting a broad area of interest to ensure planning and support services that guide them to their goals. Guided Pathways is expected to be fully implemented in Spring 2021.
