### **Mid-Management Contract Negotiations**

A union crowd was present in the Boardroom as Mid-Management Association President Kay Frey announced an 80% yes vote for the managers to strike if necessary. She stated that the group presented nine possible meeting dates to administration last Friday, October 11, and she urged that meetings be set and negotiations proceed in good faith.

Chairman Stephens reiterated that the Board and Administration stand behind its employees, discussing how mass layoffs were avoided during the two-year state budget impasse by rolling nearly \$11 million into operating funds after the 2016 bond issue.

Dates for negotiation meetings are currently being coordinated and should be set by tomorrow.

Mr. Stephens pledged that our students will continue to be served.
