Who Can Enroll in the Program?

New Students

- Who want an RN license before pursuing their BSN.

Currently Enrolled

- Students who are in the RN Program at Triton College and seek a clear path toward obtaining their BSN.

Alumni

- Graduates from Triton College's Nursing Program can be considered for admissions into this 3+1 program.
- Alumni who may not have graduated from Triton's RN Program, but completed some courses in it and may want to return to finish the A.A.S. degree.
- A transcript evaluation will need to be complete by both schools to certify that all prerequisites have been met.
- Please contact your advisor for degree and partnership requirements.

Program Overview

- The first three years are offered by Triton with the final year in Dominican University's Nursing Program.
- For students earning a BSN at ≥ 124 credit hours, including at least 83 credit hours of Triton College courses and a minimum of 41 credit hours of Dominican University coursework.
- It is recommended that students apply for admission to Dominican University at least one semester prior to completing the degree to ensure that all appropriate coursework is completed prior to entry.
- Students must meet all prerequisite coursework and must maintain a 2.75 GPA at Triton College to remain eligible for potential admission to this program.

- Triton College students must: 1) complete an online application, 2) request a final, official transcript to be sent to DU after completing the aforementioned A.A.S. degree for final verification, 3) submit a copy of an active RN license or proof of a scheduled NCLEX, 4) two letters of recommendation, 5) personal statement, and 6) completion of all prerequisite coursework.

The Advantage

The 3+1 program allows students to complete their A.A.S. degree from Triton College. Once completed, students are allowed to take additional courses beyond their degree at Triton. Dominican University teaches the final year of classes.

3+1 Benefits

- Save time and money.
- Ability to enter the nursing field prior to obtaining the bachelor's degree.
