- A transcript evaluation will need to be completed by both schools to assure all prerequisites have been met.

Program Overview

- The first three years are offered by Triton with the final year, as a combination of online and in-person by Lewis University.
- The 36 credit hours earned through Lewis University are offered at a 35% discount per credit hour.
- For students earning a BA degree in criminal justice at 128 credit hours, including 92 credit hours of Triton College courses and 36 credit hours of Lewis University coursework.



The Advantage

The 3+1 program allows students to complete their AA degree from Triton College. Once completed, students are allowed to take additional courses beyond their degree at Triton. The final year of classes is taught by Lewis University faculty.
