1. Download the Authy app from Authy's website. Downloading the app first will make later steps easier.

You should not install Authy on a shared or public computer. If you do not have your own computer, you will need to use Authy or Microsoft Authenticator on your smartphone.

You can also use this app on your smartphone, but the steps to set it up may look a little different. Download Authy from the App Store (Apple devices) or the Play Store (Android devices).
