- \_\_\_\_\_ BIS 136 (Functional Human Anatomy I) or BIS240 (Human Anatomy and Physiology I)
- \_\_\_\_\_ AHL120 (Comprehensive Medical Terminology)

*\*Completion of the Math, Science, and Allied Health prerequisites must not be more than 5 years old.*

*\*All prerequisite coursework must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.*

*\*All test scores must be within the last two years.*

*\*All coursework for graduation must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.*

*\*Students are not considered accepted into the program or eligible to register for Surgical Technology courses until they respond to their official program acceptance letter. \**
