Entry Level Programs

You've got *options*. Are you ready to take the first step toward becoming a qualified healthcare provider?

Here are some of the healthcare provider job preparation programs offered through CECHPs.

Our professionals will help you update your professional knowledge and learn new skills as they work closely with professional associations, healthcare agencies and advisory committees to create programs that are relevant, timely and educationally sound.

Dental Assistant

The 60-hour Dental Assistant Program prepares students for entry-level positions in a dental office providing quality preventative and correctional dental care under direct supervision of the dentist or hygienist.



Dialysis Technician

Students will be prepared to function as a dialysis technician under the supervision of the registered nurse or physician in a dialysis facility that provides dialysis treatment to the individuals diagnosed with acute or chronic kidney disease. Upon completion of the course the student is prepared to take the certification examination to be a certified dialysis technician.



EKG Technician

This comprehensive 60-hour EKG Technician Certification Program prepares students to function as EKG technicians and to take the NHA examination.

Medical Billing and Coding

This 200-hour course offered over two semesters is designed for healthcare professionals, billing professionals, people interested in the business aspect of healthcare and office managers. This class prepares students to sit for the NHA examination. (Three-class program.)

Medical Scribe (Online)

Medical scribes are the newest addition to the medical team. They are trained medical information managers, specializing in charting physician-patient encounters during medical examinations. Medical scribes work directly with the provider or remotely.

Optician

Opticians are professionals who work alongside optometrists or ophthalmologists. The Optician Training Program prepares students to sit for the National Opticianry Competency Exam (NOCE) offered through the American Board of Opticianry (ABO).



Pharmacy Technician

This 75-hour course will introduce students to various settings in pharmacy practice, including the community, hospital, managed care, mail order and long-term care. Information on qualifying for the pharmacy certification examination will be provided. Optional externship opportunity partnered with Walgreens is available.



Phlebotomy Technician

Phlebotomists are skilled healthcare professionals who have been trained to collect, transport, handle and process blood and other specimens for laboratory analysis using venipuncture and micro collection techniques. This course is designed for those interested in becoming phlebotomists, nurses, doctors, medical staff and anyone interested in the healthcare profession. Students are prepared for the NHA certification exam.

Students who complete the program are eligible for a one-week IV Therapy Training.

Nursing Programs

Train the Trainer - This course is designed for the RN who is interested in becoming an instructor for a basic nurse aide training program (BNATP). IDPH approved. This course includes the Evaluators Workshop component which will evaluate the student's competency demonstration of selected performance skills. Successful completion of the course will provide 34.25 CEUs through Ohio League for Nursing.

RN Re-entry

Triton College offers a 16-week RN Re-entry Program for Illinois RNs who have not actively practiced in recent years, have an active Illinois RN license and wish to return to clinical practice. The first eight weeks of the course take place on campus in a lecture classroom format to review theoretical foundations. The second eight weeks will take place at a hospital in the clinical setting administering care to patients.



Physical Therapy Aide

This 50-hour program prepares students to carry out the non-technical duties of physical therapy. Under the direction of a physical therapist or physical therapy assistant, an aide will provide services that help improve mobility, relieve pain and prevent or limit permanent physical disabilities of patients suffering from injuries or disease.

Veterinary Assistant

This 150-hour Veterinary Assistant Program prepares students for entry-level positions in the veterinary field. Participants will complete a 30-hour externship at an animal clinic within the program. Upon successful completion of this course, the student will be able to demonstrate the practical skills needed to become a valuable veterinary assistant.

CPR for Healthcare Providers

Designed for anyone in the healthcare field. Upon successful completion, participants will receive the American Heart Association CPR for Healthcare Providers card, which is valid for two years.
