





Race/Ethnicity Distribution within Triton District





Chart 2: Race/Ethnicity Distribution




Chart 4: Fall Enrollment Gender, Fall 2023 Data Source: 10th day data

Race/Ethnicity by Gender




Chart 5: Fall Enrollment Race/Ethnicity by Gender, Fall 2023 Data Source: 10th day data

Age Group Distribution




Chart 6: Fall 2023 Enrollment Age Distribution Data Source: 10th day data







Chart 9: Fall Term Enrollment Headcount, 5-yr trend Data Source: 10th day data






Chart 11: Fall Enrollment Average Credit Load, 5-yr Trend Data Source: 10th day data

Average Age of Students Enrolled in Fall Term, 2019-2023






Chart 14: Fall Enrollment Average Age, 5-yr Trend Data Source: 10th day data



Credit Hour Enrollment by Student Type in Fall Term, 2019-2023






Chart 16: Credit Students Credit Hours




Chart 17: Non Credit Students Credit Hours Data Source: 10th day data




Chart 18: New Students Credit Hours Data Source: 10th day data





Retention Rate of Full-Time, First-Time Degree/Certificate Seeking Students By Attendance Status and Cohort Year






Chart 22: Graduation Rate by Cohort Year – 5-yr Trend Data Source: IPEDS Graduation Rate Report, Winter 2022




Chart 23: Transfer Rate by Cohort Year – 5-yr Trend Data Source: IPEDS Graduation Rate Report, Winter 2022
