Triton College Men's Basketball Team will Play for the NJCAA Division I National Championship

RIVER GROVE, Ill. – The Triton College men's basketball team has advanced to the national championship game of the NJCAA Division I Championship Tournament in Hutchinson, Kansas, after their 87-84 win Thursday night over Connors State College (Oklahoma). The Trojans (34-2) will play the top-seed, Barton Community College (35-1) from Great Bend, Kansas, in the championship game on Saturday, March 30, 1 p.m. The game will be broadcast nationwide on ESPNU.

Triton is the No. 7 seed in the tournament and the championship game will be the first-ever meeting between the schools.

The title game appearance is Triton's first since moving up to NJCAA Division I. The Trojans transitioned up a level after winning the NJCAA Division II National Championship in 2018.
