

The Paralegal Studies Certificate Program prepares students for entry-level (non-attorney) legal positions. The scope of the certificate encompasses various legal specialties so that after completing this program students are prepared for a variety of legal positions whether in a law firm, corporation or governmental agency. In order to be eligible for this program, a student must have previously earned an associate or bachelor's degree.

Note: Paralegals may not provide legal services directly to the public, except as permitted by law.
