
Doctor of PHARMACY (PharmD) DIRECT ENROLLMENT PROGRAM





EARN DIRECT ADMISSION TO THE ROOSEVELT UNIVERSITY PHARMD PROGRAM

The Direct Enrollment Program (DEP), a unique partnership between Roosevelt and select community colleges and universities, provides a direct pathway for highly qualified, full-time students to gain direct admission into Roosevelt's Doctor of Pharmacy program.

To be eligible a student must...

1. Have graduated from high school (or attained the equivalent of a high school diploma)

2. Have a recommended undergraduate grade point average of a minimum of a 3.0/4.0 scale, including a math and science grade point average of at least 2.75/4.00

3. Be in the final year of completing prerequisites at one of the partner schools listed below

4. Complete a Direct Enrollment Program application

3. If recommended for admission by the Faculty Admissions Committee, accept the offer of admission and submit the enrollment deposit
