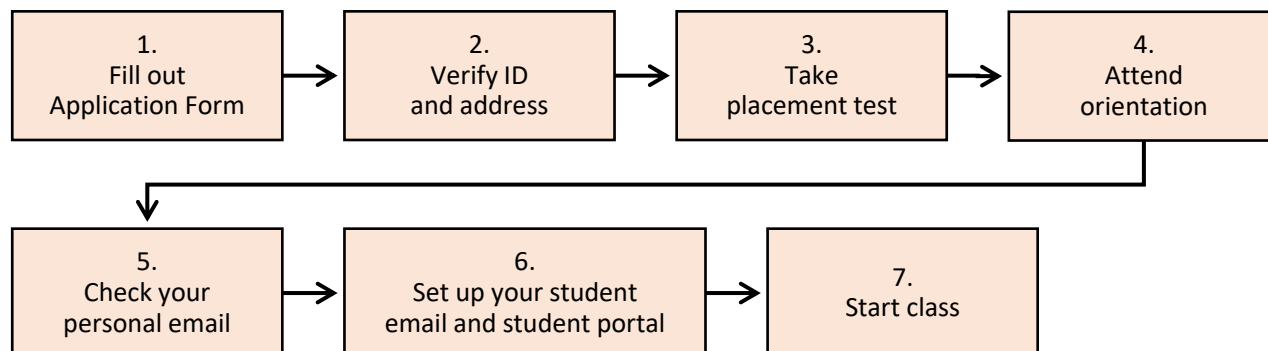


Enrollment Process for NEW GED students



You are not registered until all these steps are complete.

1. Fill out the application form at www.triton.edu/Adult-Education.
2. Come to the adult education office to verify your personal information. Bring an ID with photo and updated proof of address (if you moved recently or have an international identification).
3. Make an appointment to take the placement test required by the state of Illinois.
4. Attend an online orientation. You will receive an email invitation.
5. After orientation, a confirmation of your enrollment in class(es) will be sent to your personal email. In this email, you will also receive instructions on how to set up your student email and access your student portal. Read the email carefully.
6. Follow the instructions in the email to set up your Triton College student email and student portal. Download your class schedule (on the portal).
7. Come to class on the days listed on your class schedule. If you miss the first week, you will be dropped from class and will not be eligible to attend 15-week classes the following semester.

Eligibility: All students must live in the state of Illinois, must be at least 16 years old and not required by state law to attend middle or high school. Students under the age of 18 must complete a High School Withdrawal Form.
