Triton College's Adult Education Department now offers GED and ESL classes in the HyFlex format! What is HyFlex? In a HyFlex course, students have a choice every day whether to join their class in person or online. Students can choose to attend completely in person, completely online or switch back and forth depending on what is most convenient for them. HyFlex teachers are present in-person for all class periods, and teach online and in-person students at the same time with the help of a sound- and motion-tracking camera.

The HyFlex format has many benefits. It gives students flexibility and control over how they learn, and allows workarounds for barriers to both in-person and online attendance. Students no longer have to stop taking classes if they have technology issues or lose access to transportation. They can simply switch formats and remain in the same class with the same teacher. The format is also a great way for students to develop their digital literacy skills, as digital literacy is built into these courses from the ground up. HyFlex students, supported by their teachers, encounter numerous types of technology throughout the semester and steadily increase their confidence in using it.
